## ***Experience / Training***

### **World Ving Tsun Athletic Association – August 2006 to October 2006**

I undertook my first attempt at distance learning with Sifu Darrell Jordan, the course was good and under no circumstances take this as a negative statement, it just simply was not working for me and I needed those measures and grades to target my training which this course did not have, at this point I had learned the Siu Lim Tau form and was getting into some the hand drills, its at this point I knew what my training was lacking and headed over to the Arizona Wing Chun Association.

### **Arizona Wing Chun Association – November 2006 to June 2010**

During this time I studied via learning distance learning and travelled to the USA, Arizona, North Carolina and Chicago, I achieved a Student Grade 7, this covered the Siu Nim Tau and Chum Curriculum based on the Leung Ting Wing Tsun system.

### **International Wing Chun Martial Arts Association -November 2008 to Present**

I wanted to learn the dummy form (Muk Yan Jong) and Sifu Sam Chan taught that after Chum Kiu, and that is where I was currently with the AWCA so in the first month I passed my Siu Lim Tau with this organisation and then the next month after a few adjustments I passed my Chum Kiu level which meant I could start getting my teeth in to the dummy form. Then only three months later in March 2009 I passed the first 3 levels of the dummy form then in July after working daily and I mean everyday I completed the whole form, and then on from here I started working on the pole level and I was certified in this in June 2010, eleven months later, then four months later in October 2010 I passed my Biu Jee black sash with the IWCMAA .
